ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW COMMITTEE

Our Board of Directors has a subcommittee of volunteers formed to review any updates or changes to the exterior of your property.

You need to provide the request for review 30 days in advance of your planned adjustments for the committee to review. It is essential that our community maintains the integrity of our community for consistency and marketability

COMMUNITY GOOD TASTE RULES

The community good taste rules are in response to frequent E-mail messages and phone calls received from homeowners. We have addressed this feedback with the following list. Please let us know if we missed any issues you would like added.

Dogs: We love your dogs...but there are a few common sense rules that need to be respected:

- There is a leash law in our community, please keep your dogs on a leash at all times.
- Please don't leave your dog outside unattended barking.
- Pick up your dog's waste and dispose of properly, in a bag in your garbage can.
- Dog urine kills plants and lawns. Please be aware of where your dog is going.

<u>Cats</u>: We love cats, but they should not to be left loose to roam freely. Please keep them in your house or on a leash in your yard.

Vehicles:

- This community is zoned "residential"; therefore, all vehicles with commercial signage should be parked in your garage or on Fieldstream Drive.
- All recreational vehicles, boats etc. should be stored in your garage or at an off-site storage facility.
- Parking on the street is for visitors of the community. Either park excess vehicles in your driveway, your garage or on Fieldstream Drive.
- Parking in front of mailboxes is illegal. Many people wait for checks and medications and if your vehicle is blocking the mailbox, the US Post Office will not deliver mail.
- Parking in front of fire hydrants, or on the curb too close to stop signs is illegal. Additionally, we are restricted to
 parking on only one side of the roads. You can be ticketed and fined for any infractions by the Hilltown Township
 Police.

Misc:

- Hilltown Township has a noise ordinance- please be respectful of neighbors when playing music after 8pm.
- Please do not dispose of cigarette butts on the ground.
- Garbage should be securely fastened and on windy nights, consider putting your garbage out the morning of garbage collection.
- Homeowners are responsible for maintaining their grounds; including mowing your lawns and clearing snow from sidewalks.
- Please be considerate of neighbors and the value of our properties by using some form of weed control on your lawn.

DID YOU KNOW?

- Our semi-annual yard sale is scheduled for Saturday, April 24. Join your neighbors in putting out those items you are not using for sale to visitors from outside our community. The sale will be advertised in the *Penny* Power, and with signage at entrances, in advance of the sale. It is a great opportunity to meet some neighbors you may not know and to pick up some extra cash.

The permit looks like a lanyard (woven material worn around the neck) attached to a Hilltown police-issued laminated ID card which includes a photo of the person who is soliciting.
